**LEGALLY BLIND MAN SEES AGAIN THANKS
TO NEW VISION-SAVING PROCEDURE
(Revolutionary Implants Restore Sight To 57-Year-Old Mission Viejo Resident)**

A 57-year-old Mission Viejo resident whose eyesight was so deteriorated from both cataracts and severe myopia that he was deemed legally blind is about to have his vision restored thanks to a revolutionary new surgical procedure known as Crystalens. Gary Tosti, who despite wearing thick “Coke bottle” glasses, was stripped of his driving privileges and ability to perform most aspects of his job. Tosti had the damaged portion of his eyes repaired with the Crystalens implants by Gregg Feinerman, M.D., founder of the Feinerman Vision Center in Newport Beach and one of the few eye surgeons in the United States qualified to perform the new surgery.

Due to the severity of the case, Feinerman performed the Crystalens procedures for each of Tosti’s eyes on separate dates. Each 15-minute procedure involved Feinerman making a two-millimeter incision in the eye, vaporizing the cataract using a special ultrasound instrument and inserting the Crystalens implant. After both eyes healed for several weeks, Feinerman performed comprehensive LASIK eye surgery to correct Tosti’s extreme near-sightedness and astigmatism to give the man a new “window to the world.”

“This revolutionary new vision correction procedure, performed in tandem with an advanced form of LASIK surgery, restored Mr. Tosti’s sight and enable him to, once again, gain a new lease on life,” said Feinerman, who revealed that the Crystalens procedure also has proven effective for

restoring 20/20 vision to those needing reading glasses as well as those who require corrective lenses to see distances. "I am delighted to have been in a position to help Mr. Tosti as I know that it will make a significant impact on the quality of his life."
